

**MEMO**  
**OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE FILLING IN OF PERMITS**

1. Before carrying out international carriage by means of goods vehicles or combinations of vehicles, the haulier must fill in a permit in a legible manner in Lithuanian, English, German or Russian, stating the following:

1.1. In the 'Haulier and address' box of the permit – the name of the haulier, the address of the haulier – the names of the country, town/settlement and street where the haulier is registered;

1.2. In the box 'Vehicle registration number' of the permit – the state registration number of the goods vehicle and of the trailer or semi-trailer (in the case of a combination);

1.3. In the box 'Place and date of loading' of the permit – the names of the country and place where the goods were loaded and the date of loading; where the goods vehicle or a combination of vehicles is moving unladen, this box shall be filled with a dash;

1.4. In the box 'Name and weight (t) of the goods' of the permit – the name and weight of the goods on board the goods vehicle and on the trailer or semi-trailer (in the case of a combination); in the case of multiple carriage (multi-consignor or multi-consignee), this box shall contain the words 'Set of goods', the number of international consignment notes (CMR forms) (e.g. 'CMR 12') and the weight of the goods indicated as the total mass of all goods; in the case of a goods vehicle or combination of vehicles moving unladen, this box shall be filled with a dash;

1.5. In the box 'Date, time and place of entry/exit to/from the Republic of Lithuania' of the permit – the date, time and place of the crossing of the state border of the Republic of Lithuania, the name of the international border inspection post or, where the state border is crossed through a border inspection post other than an international border inspection post, the number of the highway or national road;

1.6. In the box 'Place and unloading' of the permit – the names of the country and the place where the goods are to be unloaded; where the goods vehicle or a combination of vehicles is moving unladen, this box shall be filled with a dash;

1.7. In the box 'Signature' of the permit – the signature of the driver;

1.8. In the box 'Place and date of issue and stamp' of the permit – the names of the foreign country and the place where the permit was issued, the date and the stamp of the competent authority of the foreign country that issued the permit.

2. The permit held by the haulier before entering (leaving) the Republic of Lithuania shall contain the information set out in sub-paragraphs 1.1–1.8 of the Rules.

3. The haulier may revise the information in the permit by deleting what was previously entered and clearly entering new information:

3.1. as set out in sub-paragraph 1.1 of the Rules, where such adjustments are authenticated by the stamp of the competent authority of the foreign country which issued the permit, which shall be identical to the original stamp of the competent authority of the foreign country which issued the permit;

3.2. as set out in sub-paragraph 1.2 of the Rules, where a breakdown has led to the replacement of the goods vehicle, trailer or semi-trailer (in the case of a combination) and the haulier has documents issued by a workshop proving the breakdown. The adjustments shall be made by the driver of the haulier and shall be signed by them.
